I, the undersigned USDA accredited veterinarian, certify that the animal/s examined and described above:

1. shows/show no clinical sign of disease.

2. is/are free from clinical signs of any infectious or contagious diseases, and to the best of my knowledge, exposure thereto, which would endanger the animal, other animals, and/or public health (via zoonoses) on the day of shipment.

3. is/are tested for all pathogens in accordance with the SPF testing protocol of the exporting facility, to include diseases/organisms such as: Salmonella, Streptobacillus moniliformis (Rat Bite Fever), Melioidosis, Plague, Hymenolepiasis, Hantavirus, and Lymphocytic Choriomeningitis Virus (LCMV), Leptospirosis.

4. is/are free of Yersinia pestis and Burkholderia pseudomallei agents as verified through routine broad-spectrum bacterial culture methods (aerobic and anaerobic).

5. originate from exporting facilities which employ vector and vermin exclusion barriers to prevent the introduction of pests, ectoparasites, dermatophytes.

was/were born and reared in an accredited specific pathogen free establishment with oversight by the competent health authority of the government of the exporting country.

6. [0] Animal(s) for non-laboratory/non-research use:
was/were kept since birth or at least the past 21 days in an establishment where there have been no cases of infectious and contagious diseases of rodents in the past 3 months and are free from signs and symptoms of any infectious or contagious diseases, which would endanger the animal, other animals, and/or public health (via zoonoses).
