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**Certification Statements:**

I, the undersigned veterinarian, hereby certify that the animals described above comply with the following requirements:

1. There have been no occurrences of unexplained mortality events on the premises of origin of the animals for export during the 60 days prior to shipment.
  
2. The premises of origin is free from the following pathogens to which they are considered susceptible per the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) Aquatic Code based on (a.) The absence of clinical, laboratory, and epidemiological evidence of these pathogens in the premises for a minimum of 2 years; AND (b.) A health monitoring and surveillance system for a minimum of 2 years, for which sampling is conducted in accordance with the current WOAH Aquatic Manual. The WOAH-listed pathogens of concern include: Acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease (AHPND), *Aphanomyces astaci* (crayfish plague), Covert mortality nodavirus (CMNV), Decapod iridescent virus 1 (DIV1), *Enterocytozoon hepatopenaei* (EHP), Infectious hypodermal and haematopoietic necrosis virus (IHHNV), Infectious myonecrosis (IMN), *Macrobrachium rosenbergii* nodavirus (white tail disease), Necrotising hepatopancreatitis (*Hepatobacter penaei*) (NHP), Taura syndrome virus (TSV), White spot syndrome virus (WSSV), and Yellow head virus genotype-1 (YHV).
  
3. If the shipment includes germplasm or post-larvae (PL), there have been no cases of WOAH-listed aquatic diseases in the broodstock used for the production of the germplasm or PL for export during the 60 days prior to shipment.
  
4. If the shipment includes germplasm or post-larvae (PL), the broodstock used in the production of the animals for export has not experienced any unexplained morbidity or mortality events during the 60 days prior to shipment at the premises of origin for pathogens of concern including, *Enterocytozoon hepatopenaei*, Spherical Baculovirus, Covert mortality nodavirus, Crustacea hepe-like virus 1, and Tetrahedral Baculovirus.
  
5. The container/packaging in which the animals for export are transported is either new or has been cleaned and disinfected prior to use.
